Vintage 2020

2020 has been the warmest year since 1800. Winter temperatures were mild, with a cool early spring followed by an April and May with either maximum and minimum above-average temperatures. After copious rainfall in the first week of June, summer continued with no precipitation but cool nights and average maximum temperatures. A clear and bright sky marked the Summer season until the end of August, when a significant rain brought the plants back to vitality and allowed them to ripen correctly. Overall, the 2020 vintage grapes show high quality, gentle and well-ripened tannins in all parcels. The harvest was shorter than usual, starting at the end of August until September the 22nd.

Winemaking

Harvest:

By hand for about 4 weeks. We started on September the 5th for the first Podere Serra all'Olio Merlot and ended with the Petit Verdot on September the 21st

Vinification:

All the different plots and varieties are vinified separately in concrete and wooden tanks, with slow spontaneous fermentations and soft extractions.

Ageing:

Once the malolactic fermentation terminates, we decide the blend of the wine selected for Caiarossa. Then the wine ages for 14 months in barriques, of which 30% is new oak. After the ageing, the wine rests in concrete tanks for two months before bottling it and then an additional year in the bottle

Alcohol:

14,5%.
