ENSELBERG GG PINOT NOIR 2020

VINEYARD:

Jechtinger Enselberg: this west-facing, windy vineyard with a spectacular view towards the Rhine plains is characterized by its partially bright, partially dark and stony volcanic soil on the bottom, topped with a fine layer of loess. In 1999 and 2003, the 100% Burgundian Pinot Noir clones were planted in these two parcels, bringing forth a delicate and feminine type of Pinot Noir.
