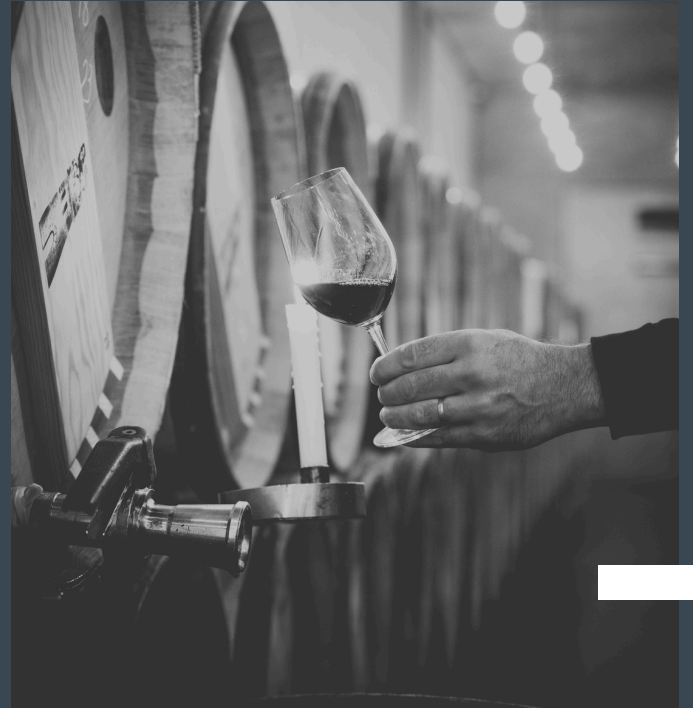


2012 VINTAGE

The 2012 vintage is distinguished by its late development, shaped by a cool, damp spring and a remarkably dry end to the season. This unique climatic rhythm fostered a slow, gradual veraison, endowing the harvest with remarkable complexity and diversity.

The 2012 Latour...wine of the vintage?

It has to be a serious contender. In this blind taste-off between the five First Growths, its quality shines through. With exceptional delineation on the nose, it just oozes class with precise black fruit, crushed stone, mint and light sous-bois. **The palate is perfectly balanced with a fine line of acidity, as precise as a Swiss watch, gently building to a finish that delivers the structure one expects from a Latour. Sheer class.**

The 2012 Les Forts de Latour has a light minty bouquet, more red than black fruit, touches of orange peel and light pencil shaving scents. **The palate is medium-bodied with good density, fine tannins, becoming increasingly precise towards the finish, graphite and black pepper lingering on the aftertaste.** Wonderful breeding here, a step ahead of other Deuxième Vins.
