

# DOMAINE DE BARONARQUES

Once owned by the 8th-century Benedictine abbey of Saint-Polycarpe, Domaine de Baronarques is rooted in the Aude region of Languedoc, a historic centre of French winegrowing. Since 1998, the estate has taken its rightful place alongside the famous Bordeaux châteaux which now belong to Camille Sereys de Rothschild, Philippe Sereys de Rothschild and Julien de Beaumarchais de Rothschild. Located at the meeting point of two maritime influences, the vineyard is planted with Atlantic varieties (Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon) and Mediterranean varieties (Syrah, Malbec). This wine's distinctive style combines refinement and elegance with the power typical of its exceptional terroir, exalted by the family's legendary know-how.
