



KIRCHBERG GG PINOT NOIR 2020

VINEYARD:

Oberrotweiler Kirchberg; in this south-/southwest facing vineyard you can feel the influence of the Belfort Gap especially well. The soil of the west facing, more exposed, parts of this parcel have more gravel. Generally it is always a bit cooler here, compared to Schlossberg and Eichberg. This Pinot Noir vineyard was planted in 1975 by Fritz Keller. Due to the bright calcareous volcanic gravel the wine turns out delicate and rather low-key.

Bright cherry notes with floral hints of hibiscus and roses, delightful oak aromas, already well-integrated tannin. In comparison with Eichberg and Schlossberg GG this Pinot Noir is rather feminin.
