Essence and personality

Latest addition to Pujanza family. La Paul vineyard, base of this wine, is located on a hillside facing east on the slopes of the town of Laguardia and stood out for its essence and personality since its acquisition.

VARIETY: Tempranillo.

HARVEST & VINIFICATION: manual harvesting and grape sorting directly in the vineyard. Spontaneous fermentation with light daily pumping over.

CASK AGEING: 12 months in 225 L. French oak barrels & 12 months more in concrete vats.

APPEARANCE: deep dark cherry colour with purple hints.

NOSE: suggestive, full of pleasant fruit aromas, basically elegant ripe fruits, mineral hints and well integrated wood.

PALATE: lush, wide and round, presents a good freshness and balance. Fruity, expressive and lingering finish.

Vineyard: Finca La Paul

Vineyard Located at 610 m above sea level. Clay-limestone, stony soil. Vines planted in slope with east-west orientation. West exposition, receiving morning sun.
