# WINEMAKER'S TASTING NOTES

Inviting and expressive bouquet with aromas of blackcurrant and plum, supported with all spice nuances from barrel maturation. The palate starts out plush with dark fruit and tight-knit tannins. The wine has an elegant and refined structure.

### 2019 HARVEST

Grapes were hand-picked from the beginning of February to the end of March 2019. A relatively small crop with cool conditions during ripening.

### WINEMAKING

Fermented in stainless steel tanks with regular pumping over of the must onto the skins for even, elegant extraction. Malolactic fermentation was done before barrel maturation.
