Valteiro is a small *peza* (plot) classified and located in the village of Portela. It was planted from María Ardoña in 1985 by D. Francisco Prada Gayoso, continuing the family tradition of preserving indigenous Galician grape varieties, with the desire to obtain a wine that would reflect the inherent elegance of the variety through the minerality of Valteiro's special soil.
