Vintage 2021

2021 gave us a very classic, Moseltypical Riesling year. After a cool, wet spring and changing weather in summer, September brought us a lot of sun and cool nights and therefore encouraged a great aroma development. The harvest can be characterized by many various selective procedures in mid October and this rewarded our very precise handwork with perfect healthy grapes by limited quantity. The 2021 Rieslings present themselves very fine, pure with an enormous minerality, lively acidity and great fruit balance.

Wine

VDP.Grosses Gewächs is the designation for the highest quality German vineyards - wines notable for their individual character and ability to express the essence of their vineyard of origin. Juffer Sonnenuhr is the heart piece of the Brauneberger Juffer with steepness up to 80%. The wines are very elegant and fine with delicate aromas of stone fruits.
