

Vin de Pays de l'Atlantique

Surface area Selection from a 2 hectares plot of vines (5 acres)

Geographical situation South-facing slope, Castillon-la-Bataille

Soils Clay-limestone with high limestone tuff rock content

Density of plantation 5,000 to 7,000 vines/ha

Grape composition 40% Chardonnay,

20 % Chenin,

20% Sauvignon Blanc,

20% Sémillon

Pruning Respectful of the flow of the sap,

adapted to the vigour of the grape variety

and to the soil-type

Harvesting Picking date according to berry sampling

and the pH for optimal ripeness and to guarantee freshness of flavour

Vinifications - Direct pressing under inert gas

- Cold settling of the juices

- Fermentation in new barrels, stainless steel tanks

and concrete eggs at low temperature

Ageing 18 months at low temperature on the fine lees

with batonnage in new barrels and concrete egg

Totale surface area 131 hectare (324 acres), including 62 hectares

in Saint-Émilion
