



Château Cap de Faugères 2020

Castillon – Côtes de Bordeaux

June 2021 – Weinwisser 17/20

May 2021 – Markus del Monego 92+/100

Dark purple colour with violet hue and black core. Elegant nose with refined fruit and floral hints in the background. Subtle oak and mild spices. On the palate well structured, juicy and rich, with ripe fruit, velvety tannins and appetizing freshness, well balanced with convincing lengh.

May 2021 – Jeff Leve, The Wine Cellar insider 91-93/100

Dark in color, the wine offers an array of scents, featuring black cherry liqueur, olives, licorice and coffee bean. Lush, round, rich and fruity, the finish packs in a lot of sweet, ripe, dark red pit fruits and chocolate.

May 2021 – Decanter, Jane Anson 90/100

Austere kicks to the tannins but it is enjoyable, with plum and sage flavours that come in waves through the palate. Pretty subdued overall but enjoyable. Owned by Silvio Denz

April 2021 – Jeb Dunnuck 91-93/100

Always a smoking wine (as well as a hard to beat value), the 2020 Château Cap De Faugères boasts a deep purple hue as well as lots of cassis and blueberry fruits interwoven with notes of violets, white flowers, and chocolatey oak. Drink this medium to full-bodied, plush, sexy, fruit-loaded rock star of a Castillon over the coming decade.

April 2021 – James Suckling

A medium-bodied red with plum and berry. Soft and refined with nice, ripe and creamy tannins. Very polished.
