MADAME DE BEAUCAILLOU HAUT-MÉDOC 2024

Quite a scented nose of minerals and pure fruit. Medium-bodied on the palate, with chewy tannins and a tight-grained finish. Good structure and length, even if it's not polished. Linear in the middle. 63% merlot, 34% cabernet sauvignon and 3% petit verdot.

Dark purple colour with violet hue an almost black core. Expressive nose with pure fruit, aroma reminiscent of blackcurrants and blackcurrant spurs, fine spiciness and very subtle oak. On the palate medium bodied, the length is excellent, the fruit quotes the nose and is complemented by fine aromatic herbs in the finish, convincing length.

What impressed me most about Madame de Beaucaillou 2024 was its soft, velvety texture. As soon as the wine touches the palate, the powdery tannins quickly awaken the taste buds, bringing a sense of joy. The wine's full body remains its strongest suit, though the slightly simple fruit aromas left me a bit disappointed. Overall, this is a Haut-Médoc where the palate outweighs the bouquet, and perhaps with another five years of aging, it will become even more delightful.

Château Ducru Beaucaillou Haut-Médoc Madame de Beaucaillou 2024

Beautiful clarity of fruit, delivering lean but vivid cherry and spiced savoury plum, with tannins that are present but not overly tight. Harvested around 35hl/h yield, then ended up in the bottle at 20-25hl/h yield, giving you some idea of the sorting needed to tease out the best wines of the vintage. Increased footprint of vines, with 20ha added from the purchase of Chateau Doroux, in Cussac Fort Médoc, but still the final amount saw around 50% of the usual production. 11% press wine. 3.6 pH. harvest 22 September to 10 October, 20% new oak.

2024 Madame De Beaucaillou

The 2024 Madame De Beaucaillou is based on two-thirds Merlot and one-third Cabernet Sauvignon (with a splash of Petit Verdot). It has a juicy, medium-bodied, elegant profile that does well in the vintage, with bright black cherry and cassis fruit, hints of tobacco and violet, supple tannins, and a good finish.

Madame de Beaucaillou (Haut-Médoc) 2024: The Haut-Médoc from the team at Ducru-Beaucaillou is a blend of 63% Merlot, 34% Cabernet Sauvignon and 2% Petit Verdot, from 55 hectares of vines in Listrac-Médoc and Cussac-Fort-Médoc (although subsequent purchases have since expanded this by 20 hectares). Not a vigorous expression on the nose of this wine, but there are dark summer hedgerow berries, beneath a toasty and matchsticky overlay. The texture is attractive, with rather reserved fruit, and a dense and peppery backbone of tannins. There is attractive substance and confident grip here, the tannins feeling quite ripe for the vintage, and despite its reticent character this shows well. The alcohol is 13.27%. 87-89/100 (April 2025)

From: Event Horizon: Bordeaux 2024 Primeur (May 2025)

The 2024 Madame de Beaucaillou includes an additional 20 hectares rented in Cussac, although the volume is unchanged due to sorting. This aged in 20% new oak. This has a forward, rounded, sensual bouquet due to the contribution of the Merlot, lending it a Right Bank allure. The palate is medium-bodied with a bright opening. Tensile with fine sapidity, this just misses a little sustain on the finish. Otherwise, it should drink well over the next decade.

Deep garnet-purple in color. Opens with compelling notes of black raspberries, kirsch, and spice box, followed by hints of cardamom and dusty soil. The medium-bodied palate is lightly chewy with just enough freshness and a peppery finish.
