TASTING NOTES

PRODUCTION

12 104 bottles of 0,75L.

VINIFICATION

Manual harvest to 40Kg baskets, bunch selection in a sorting table, no pumps, gravity flow. Natural racking after 24 hours, and fermentation in small 600 to 1000L stainless steel tanks.

ALCOHOL

12% Vol.

WINE PAIRING

Fresh, elegant, salty and spicy red. Enjoy with well flavoured dishes of either simple red meats or well seasoned white meats.

STORE AND SERVICE

Store at 12-14°C and serve at 16°C to drink at 18°C.
