1. For more than 15 years, all our estate wines have been cultivated and vinified according to the principles of sustainable agriculture. Since 2015, we have been striving not to use any chemical products on our land. At the same time, we have implemented a thorough and ecological tillage of the soil.

2. As of the 2018 harvest, the property is certified HVE 3 (High Environmental Value) "an official recognition of the environmental performance of winegrowers", in order to have a recognised eco-responsible approach.
