An urban single vineyard in the heart of the city of Reims Historical hectare of the House dating back to the 18th century facing the Cathedral The only hectare of vineyard left in the city Harvested by the employees of the House with a strict selection of the grapes A vintage every year since 2006

2/ A location, a terroir

Single vineyard at the top of the Courlancy hill right above the Lanson cellars Very chalky soil & microclimate 100% Chardonnay. Massal selection Vineyard farmed under the biodynamics principles Certified HVE since 2019

3/ Elaboration

Vinification in oak barrels from the Argonne forest NML Minimum 10 years of ageing in cellars A very low dosage – Extra Brut

4/ A rare wine

A single plot, one grape and one year A very limited quantity of bottles for each vintage Each bottle comes in CB1 (French forest)
