The vineyards experienced dry conditions with the second lowest rainfall in Opus One's history. The team took advantage of the dryness to cultivate early to avoid competition for limited water. Cooler temperatures and late March rains arrived in time for delayed bud-break on April 7th. Warmer weather in April and May allowed for ideal shoot growth; flowering began on May 17th. Reduced water led to smaller yields, giving exceptional concentration and flavor. Harvest began on August 31st and completed on September 24th.

The Opus One 2021 effuses seductive, dark-fruit aromas of crushed cassis and blackberry with hints of violet, vanilla, and baking spices. Bright on the attack, concentrated flavors mirror the aromas and are coupled with a creamy texture mid-palate from the fine-grained tannins. Poignant notes of black tea, licorice, and dark chocolate lead to a long lingering finish.
