<i>Surface area</i>	65,5 hectares (162 acres)
<i>Geographical situation</i>	Southern slope of Castillon-la-Bataille Natural amphitheatre in Sainte-Colombe Clay-limestone at Francs
<i>Soils</i>	Cold clay-limestone with tuff rock and marl on the southern slope and high clay content in the natural amphitheatre.
<i>Density of plantation</i>	5,000 to 7,000 vines per hectare depending on the characteristics of the soil
<i>Grape composition</i>	95% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc
<i>Pruning</i>	Respectful of the flow of the sap, adapted to the vigour of the grape variety and to the soil-type
<i>Harvesting</i>	Picking date according to berry sampling for optimal ripeness
<i>Vinifications</i>	In temperature-controlled stainless steel vats - Cold soak at 8°C - Alcoholic fermentation up to 28°C - Fast running off of the wine after fermentation
<i>Vatting</i>	Immediately after the running off process
<i>Ageing</i>	Traditional Bordeaux ageing
<i>Totale surface area</i>	131 ha (324 acres), including 62 hectares in Saint-Émilion
<i>Winemaker and Oenologist</i>	Hubert de Bouard de Laforest
