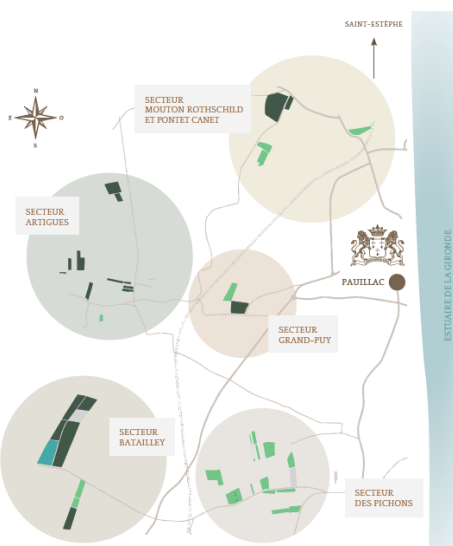

The 2025 Château Grand-Puy-Ducasse Pauillac is **bright, ripe and succulent**, with an underlying juiciness that really drives the blackberry and black currant fruit along. It's fresh and well-defined and continues the trend line here for an estate that is coming on strong.

Cassis, graphite, spicy wood, and floral nuances all define the 2025 Château Grand-Puy Ducasse, a beautiful effort ranking with the best wines from this château. Medium to full-bodied on the palate, it has a pure, graceful mouthfeel, ultra-fine tannins, and wonderful overall balance. It's a beautifully classic, satisfying Pauillac in the making.

Lovely fragrance and intensity of aromatics, blackcurrants and cherries with some dried herbal notes. Supple and grippy, chalky and filling but with such delicacy that it's not at all overwhelming. Young but not really tight or too focused, it settles after a few minutes opening up the ripe black fruit. Mouthwatering acidity perfectly balances the tannins and structure without one part being over the top. I like the restrained style but there's still an undercurrent of blueberries, cola, mint, liquorice and graphite. Assured and confident. Spiced.
