DE VENOGE IS ALL AFLAME WITH ITS NEW CUVÉE

The Champagne House of de Venoge unveils its new cuvée, La Flamme.

A veritable declaration of love to the House's nineteenth-century town house - the sublime Hôtel de Venoge - the cuvée is inspired by the masterpiece that illuminates the grand staircase of the residence, an art nouveau stained glass window listed as a historic monument and designed by master glassworker Jacques Grüber, an icon of the Nancy school. The slender shape of a flame, a symbolic theme of Art Nouveau, which adorns the box of this precious cuvée, echoes its aesthetic codes with the warm colours of the stained glass window's central sun and its divine energy. A flamboyant tribute to a place whose treasures never cease to inspire the Maison de Venoge.

Luminous and warm, La Flamme also pays tribute to the 2018 vintage, a particularly sunny year in Champagne.

Its golden colour with delicate, brilliant highlights and fine bubbles evoke all the subtlety and light of a dancing flame. The nose is flamboyant with its beautiful aromatic complexity combining notes of dry fruit and gingerbread. Round and complex on the palate, La Flamme reveals remarkable energy, very sunny, a perfect balance between the power of Pinot Noir and the elegance of Chardonnay.
