Grand Vin de Léoville
du Marquis de Las Cases

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In the heart of the Chateau Léoville Las Cases, one can admire two twin Italian mirrors from the 18th Century. In fact, when one chooses to look closely at them, minute differences could be noted.

It is said to be a signature in Italian art, objects created in pairs will always bear tiny, hardly noticeable differences, so one element would be for Madame, and one for Monsieur.

Our “Collection Miroir” is a very limited edition of two sister cases, one complementing the other, one reflecting the other. The first one would be named “Millésimes Secrets” – Secret Vintages and the other one would be “Millésimes Historiques” – Historical Vintages.

Establishing such a special case is never easy. Determining a selection of laudatory praised vintages that are all the same ready to be enjoyed from now on, was a great challenge, but finalizing a shortlist of lesser known, forgotten or misunderstood vintages was even trickier. The consistency of the Grand Vin of Léoville Las Cases is such that many vintages would have deserved to be included in this case.

So it was decided to create two cases instead of one.

The Grand Vin de Léoville du Marquis de Las Cases, most of the time called « Léoville Las Cases », is known for its balance, its elegance and its tremendous ageing capacity. Even though it can be enjoyed in its youth, those who have had the opportunity to taste ancient vintages, are aware of the expected and moving experience in seeing their patience rewarded, no matter the quality of the vintage.

Each vintage you now own was carefully chosen, each bottle matured in our cellars until it was prepared and laid down in this case.
