



SCHLOSSBERG GG PINOT NOIR 2020

VINEYARD:

Achkarrer Schlossberg; this part of the vineyard is surrounded by a stonewall and can only be cultivated by hand. The stonewall is up to 4 meters high and about 150 meters long. Secured by our team, it will last for generations. Lizards, snakes, and fire salamander find shelter, especially during the winter. The Pinot Noir vines here were replanted from old vines (sélection massale).
