## Château HAUT -PIQUAT

LUSSAC SAINT- EMILION

GRAPES : 80% Merlot ,15% Cabernet Sauvignon,  
5% Cabernet franc

OWNER : Jean Pierre RIVIÈRE  
CONSULTANT : Hervé Romat

LOCATION: In the heart of the village of Lussac ,north  
east from Saint-Emilion.

AREA : 20Ha

SOIL : Limestone plateaux and hillside red clay

VINIFICATION : reasoned culture, with almost no weed-  
killer nor chemical fertilizer ; stripping and green  
harvesting. Vinification in thermo-regulated stainless steel  
vats at low temperature with regular pumping and ageing  
in French Oak barrels for 12 months (1/3 new barrels, 1/3  
1 year old barrels,1/3 2 years old barrels)

TASTING: Ideally located, Château HAUT PIQUAT  
produces a fine and generous good-keeping wine with a  
deep purple colour, a complex nose of red fruits and  
vanilla. The aromas are balanced and harmonious. The  
nose is confirmed by the palate. Excellent length.

1. For more than 15 years all our estate wines are cultivated and vinified in the respect of the reasoned culture principles ... Since 2015, we do not use any chemical fertilizer anymore .Besides we have set up a true ecological work of the soils.
