

## DATE SHEET

**Surface area**: 6,82 hectares, on one single piece of land **Geographic position**: Eastern, Southern and South-western slopes of the Saint-Emilion hill and plateau

Soils: clay-limestone

**Plantation density**: 6000 to 7500 vines per hectare

**Grape Varieties**: 100% Merlot,

Average age of the vines: 40 years old

**Vine growing**: vines are grown traditionnally and a proportion of rows are grassed down; de-budding is carried out, followed by green harvests.

Harvest: picked by hand

**Enologists**: Hubert de Boüard de Laforest

and Emmanuelle d'Aligny-Fulchi

**Winery**: wooden, concrete and stainless steel vats, all equipped with temperature control.

Fermentation on skins: 2 to 3 weeks

Wines go into barrels: straight after they have been run-off

**Annual production**: approximately 20 000 bottles

Maturation: 16 to 20 months

**Bottling**: at the estate
