Valteiro is the name of a small *peza* located in the village of Portela. Mr. Francisco Prada Gayoso, continuing the family tradition of preserving native galician grape varieties, planted this plot with *María Ardoña* in 1985 convinced of the potential of this grape to produce a world class wine able to show the varietal elegance of the minerality produced by the particular soils of Valteiro.

GRAPE VARIETY	María Ardoña 100%, clon familiar
APPELLATION	Valdeorras D.O.P.
VILLAGE	Portela
PLOT	Valteiro, 1 st Class (Premier Cru), 0,3 has, Altitude: 500 m., double guyot.
SOILS	The vineyard sits over a pediment gentle slope, its soil formed by silica gravels and an iron-rich matrix of sand and clay.
VINES AGES	27 years
WINE ANALYSIS	Alc. /Vol.: 13,20%, Res. Sugar: 2,0g/L, Total Ac.: 4,6g/L, pH: 3,6
FERMENTATION	Wild yeasts in open steel tank with manual cap plunging.
MATURATION	6 months in 500L french oak barriques, 18 months in tank, 6 months in bottle
